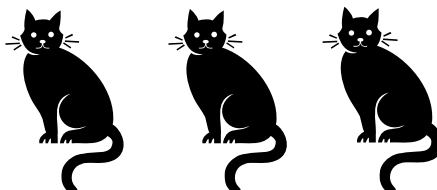

Many years ago the Isle of Thanet Branch decided that they would like to build an animal centre where they could keep and care for their animals rather than have to pay expensive commercial kennel and cattery fees. Thus began 11 years of hard work by a small handful of people to raise the funding for such a centre.

Over the years all kinds of events have been organised and donations have been received. Thanks to the ever-increasing profile of the branch locally several legacies have also been received, the very first one being from Theodora Pullinger.

The search for the right site to build such a centre was difficult and long. The Branch was determined to find a piece of land where dog kennels could be built. Eventually the piece of land at Woodchurch was found and the 5 acre site was purchased in 2003. Finally in January 2006 work began on the centre. Currently we have an administration block, a block of 15 cat pens, temporary accommodation for small number of rabbits and rodents & Manager's living accommodation. The building of the much needed cat and dog isolation blocks is nearly complete seeing the first dogs arriving at the centre soon. The next phase of building will be a block of dog kennels when funding becomes available, followed by a further cattery and purpose built small animal accommodation.

As you can imagine the cost of building and running such a centre is enormous and as we receive no financial help either from the Government or the central RSPCA the branch is Totally responsible for finding all its own funding. To this end we have started the "4000 Club" in which we are asking people to donate £2 per month by Standing Order (more can be given if you wish). If you feel that you can help us in this way it really

would be appreciated and would enable us to continue our dream of a brighter future for animals. If you would like to help us in any other way perhaps you could tick the appropriate boxes on the back of the form.
